

## Code of Conduct for Parents/Carers

The Code of Conduct for Parents/Carers applies to all parents/carers in Fencing to encourage the safety and enjoyment of everyone involved in our sport. It is based on the British Fencing Code of Conduct for Parents/Carers. This Code does not supersede the British Fencing Code of Conduct for Parents/Carers but is in addition to it.

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and fence within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performance of all.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Encourage and guide your child to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- Recognise when your child has done their best.
- Never verbally or physically abuse your child for failure.
- Ensure your child arrives at training on time and is collected promptly at the end of sessions.
